

# Advanced Westlaw Research Skills for Students

## Westlaw AU, Westlaw UK, Westlaw Classic

### Session Overview

This course is designed for students who have already completed a preliminary legal research module. The course caters for intermediate to advanced users of Westlaw and is ideal for 3rd, 4th and 5th year students who may be working on a research task, a thesis or interested in international law.

- Clarify document delivery options including download, print and email
